The work by **David Ymbernon** (Igualada, 1972) is a very personal, always bold and fresh proposal, which is impossible to classify in a particular trend. It embraces various disciplines:

painting, drawing, collage, digital photography, objectsculpture, performances, theater and poetry. The orange colour leads us into a world that awakens our imagination, by showing us how to appreciate the inconsequential, and subverting the meanings of things. In the Ymbernon universe, intuition, memories and freedom deserve the leadership.

The exhibition *Latung La La's notebook*, consist in a serie of images that have a relationship with the painting "Tractor" (2012-2015) and the short story "Blanc's Orange tractor (Siset's grandfather)", also written by David Ymbernon. Tractor is a large painting in which an orange tractor moves through an also orange landscape. David Ymbernon started painting this work in Joan Prats-Artgràfic gallery, during the performance that took place in the exhibition *Grills i òpera of Latung La La* (2012) and ended it later in his studio. For us, this fact makes sense because it makes us consider this

exhibition, as a continuation of that one, and of our personal and professional career. The tale "Blanc's orange tractor" presents all the elements that we find in David Ymbernon's art: life, family, roots, life, work, friendship, music, games, the country life, irony, poetry and the



idea that in order to escape, it is not necessary to make a long journey. Latung La La, incognito protagonist of his works, thinks that everything is possible from home and wearing sleepers.
