

The El Quadern Robat gallery shows some of his paintings and drawings

Jordi Martoranno, born in Girona in 1965, has a solid and coherent career, and his work is the reflection of austere and essential approaches to painting.

He has not exhibited in Barcelona for twenty years, and now he returns with the exhibition '['Pleroma-Uroboros'](#)', which refers to the scientific term used to refer to primitive consciousness, right at the dawn of humanity.

In this exhibition we will be able to see a series of recent drawings and oil paintings made between 2017 and 2018. In them he has carried out an exercise to understand the importance of symbols, and how they lead us to ideas beyond entertainment.

According to the same author, symbols build and sustain the universe and, on a human level, they are the essence with which we were created and with which we continue to evolve in the social, cultural, spiritual and technological fields.




