Change of scenery. The area of Enric Granados is reaffirmed as a second centrality in Barcelona, along with the traditional Consell de Cent Street. Last spring we were able to celebrate the opening to the new Marlborough Barcelona gallery - Enric Granados, 68 - with an individual show by Manolo Valdés (until September 13, August closed). But it has also opened El Quadern Robot, a main floor in the Eixample. It is directed by Anna Belsa, who was in charge of the Joan Prats-Artgràfic gallery, where artists such as Jordi Alcaraz, Chema Madoz and Jorge Pombo exhibited for the time. The inaugural exhibition, *Un canvi d'aires* (A change of scenery), includes drawings on marble by Elena Kervinen, photographs by Jordi Casañas, interesting for the conscious and dosed use of color, as well as some selected works of the before mentioned artists and by Alfonso Borrell, Carmen Calvo, Eyru, Hernández Pijuan and Ràfols Casamada among others. *El Quadern Robot.
