

January 2008 Jorge R. Pombo (Barcelona, 1973) inaugurated the exhibition Cities in Galeria Joan Prats-Artgràfic, Barcelona. I always thought his work was a chronicle of all the reflections he made during his travels. Philosophical, emotional, artistic and sensorial reflections. After the series of paintings dedicated to trips train across northern Europe (shown in the exhibition *Intro*, in 2002), came the series of white paintings, fruit of his stays in Greenland and that were shown under the explicit title of Blanco 2004. The works of the exhibition Cities presented different overlays of images of several cities. Jorge R. Pombo described his artistic statement: "Behind the overlapping of images of buildings, there is a concept of architectural zapping, as a metaphor of culture. (...) In the same physical space coexist: Cities, stories, cultures ... a fight of opposites, that are complementary at the same time. I am fascinated by analytic cubism and, in fact, it could be the seed of my current series of superpositions. I love this way of codifying figuration, in which unfold innumerable geometric forms that create the sensation of a fourth plastic dimension".

Jorge R. Pombo went on the investigation on cities as a pictorial issue. Parallel to the overlapping of images, he began to paint the cities from above, moving away from his point of observation and placing it at the level of geographic research satellites. It was the beginning of the *Maps* series. *Istanbul* was the first city to be painted from the sky. It was after a

trip he made. From the plane, he discovered a new and attractive pictorial form. He began to see the city as a concrete physical space in which the individual develops. An artificial space, codified, that determines human life. After Istanbul came New York City, where the artist currently lives. It is especially striking that the name of the city, written on top or bottom of the paintings, is always struck out with sharp strokes. As he explains, it is the way in which he reflects the tension that the idea of city contains in itself. His pictures try to transmit the reactions of people trying to adapt in an artificial physical space. Cohabitation means also the creation of strict norms and conventions, which restrain behavior and condition it. In *Lucca* series, the most recent, he introduces a new element, which in this case is paradigmatic: the city is surrounded by a line that strongly emphasizes the idea of bounded territory, it becomes a kind of real framework for the place in which social relations develop and restrain symbolically the freedom of people.

The series of maps, contrary to what can be thought, are much more expressive than intellectual *stricto sensu*. Expression is perhaps, the common denominator of all his work; From the first landscapes of the late 90s, through the various series devoted to baroque painting and, lately, the cities. Undoubtedly, the attitude of **Jorge R. Pombo** makes me think of all the artists of the past who, obsessively, sought the answer to the three eternal questions: Who are we? Where do we come from? Where do we go ?.






















Lucca 10 2013, oil on canva 170 x 190 cm *(66,92 x 74,80 in)*
